- 1. The Defendant entered a *pro se* plea of no contest to Grand Theft and Contracting Without a License During a State of Emergency on October 6, 2008.
- 2. The Defendant was adjudicated guilty on each count and was sentenced to two (2) years of probation, concurrent on each, with the special conditions that he pay fees, costs and restitution.
- 3. The Defendant's probation was successfully terminated on November 15, 2007.

The Office of the State Attorney has since received information that a second individual is actually more culpable in this crime and lied to law enforcement during the investigation of this Defendant. a State of Emergency and stipulates to the entry of a new Judgment and Sentence with the entry of the same sentence with the exception that the Defendant would receive a withhold of adjudication.
